The above figures will show the increased use of the building and consequent taxing of all of its facilities, and small staff. This year with the completion of the English Room, the Pine Room was again freed for meetings and an attempt was made not to use it for meal service unless absolutely necessary. The west end of the ballroom was furnished with the old lounge furniture in order to use it as a meeting room. The Men's lounge though very undesirable because of noise from the main lounge and lobby is continually used for smokers, teas, meetings with a speaker. On a number of occasions the student activities office has been pressed into service for meetings of small groups. Also, the cafeteria is used when no other rooms are available.
