Again I'm calling upon you for help. I think I told you I still am holding the Rehabilitation Program as my goal in the Navy. I have been told that the quickest possible way to get into it is by applying for Officers Training as soon as my 6 months are up here. That time is growing nigh and my officer has suggested that I get all of the necessary material together & have it ready at least by Aug. 1. so I'm asking you to write another letter of recommendation for me and this time it is to be in triplicate copy. Maybe you still have the one on file that you wrote for me last Sept. to the Office of Naval Officer Procurement in H.C. & can just send 3 copies of it.

I have never been sorry that my application reached Wash. D.C. too late last fall for me to get into the last class of Officers from Civilian life; for life of an Enlisted WAVE has certainly given me a view of Navy life that a lot of our officers should have had.
