Dear Doc,

I was really thrilled to get your letter, I am ashamed though, because I believe I owed you one. Any way thanks a lot. As always your words serve as a great morale booster & I enjoy them immensely. I might tell you a little about what we are doing & have been doing.

I am now in my seventh week of anti-aircraft officers training. I haven't failed a subject as yet. We take one subject a week, and 2 failures result in one's being sent home.

The courses have been all new to me. Such subjects as Searchlights, basic electricity, heightfinders, Map Reading, Gun material (90 mm) Gun gunnery, Directors Automatic weapons etc. are offered.

I am lucky in that I am used
