coming to Kansas to do graduate work.

I was struck by his studious and earnest habits, his close application to details, and his ability to assimilate instruction. Pfitsch came on to Kansas and made a fine record. His work was very thopough, and he was punctual and eager to do all the work that he undertook. His enthusiasm is unbounded, but he has the ability to assimilate.

He was an assistant in our Department of Physical Education. He worked in the intramwals department and his leadership in organizing and officiating was unusual. He officiated a great many of the intramural matches in all sports, and his attitude of fairldealing and courteous yet firm execution in the enforcement of penalties won him much respect among the students of the University. He is clean, capable and resourceful. And above all he is highly dependable. He is loyal to an unusual degree.
