Mr. Buckley was 58 years old. He is survived by a sister, Miss Ellen Buckley of the home, 4206 the Paseo.

Mr. Buckley was a member of the Kansas City Athletic club world championship basketball team in 1904. He was a life member of the Elks club, active in the St. James Holy Name society and the Kansas City Coal Dealers association. He was a veteran of the first World war.
