For your information, and as a guide to our request, our fees are determined upon the following basis:

\$20.00 Game fee First class train or bus fare Per day expenses 5.00 Per day time lost - school group

- non-school group

10.00 (sat. not included) 7.00 (six day basis)

("time lost" is to compensate those men who must be away from regular jobs and are necessarily docked. They are paid regardless of whether they are actually docked.)

I wish to submit this report to our next meeting in June, and will consider it a special favor if you can provide me with this information, or place this communication in the hands of anyone who might do it for you.
