You will remember that you also said that Van Reen of St. Louis would be ok. He couldn't get away, he has an important meeting there that night, something to do with the defense program.

These games were schedules late, and at that time all assignments in the Big Six and Missouri Valley conference had been made, leaving very few recognized officials available. We can get an official released from any minor college game when it is absolutely necessary but can't do that with the Major Conferences. I think we are fortunate that we were able to get four fine officials for these two games. Unless we had been able to get Curtis and Carroll for the game in Stillwater I hate to think of whom we would have had to take.
