Dear Doctor Allen:

For the past ten or twelve years, the writer has been officiating high school basketball and high school football contest here in Iowa. He has succeeded in building up a very fine officiating schedule, working as many as ninety basketball games during the season and twenty to twenty-two football contests. He also officiated for some of the colleges, members of the Iowa conference; and was one of the two officials working the State Junior College Basketball Tournament last spring.
