Dear Friends:

Miss Edna A. Hill, head of the Department of Home Economics, wrote me today that the University people had met with so many difficulties in getting Myers Hall ready for the nursery that the Chancellor had allowed Miss Hill to rent the University-owned house at 1100 Missouri Street.

Since it is necessary to move the nursery from New York School in four weeks, the decision had to be made without an opportunity for the Nursery Committee to meet. I was informed by Miss Hill that she had contacted Mr. Dean, Mrs. Turney and Mrs. O'Brien, and I am merely writing the information as I get this from Miss Hill. I was not present at any of the meetings but was happy that progress on the nursery has gone forward. The plumbing difficulty presented the greatest problem, but that has been worked out satisfactorily due to the new location.

I do not believe that it is necessary now to have a committee meeting unless at some time in the near future we could arrange one so that the members could meet the new personnel of the Nursery School. However, it would of necessity be an evening meeting because they are busily engaged during the noon hour. For that reason I am making this progress report to every member, trusting that the action is highly satisfactory and pleasing to the members of the board.
