
SWIMMING POOL STANDARDS

Dr. Williams says in his Introduction "There is no longer need for those who build pools to continue the errors of construction that have occurred so frequently nor for those who administer them to fail in important sanitary and educational considerations." The author, in the preparation of his book, has literally covered thousands of sources from ancient to modern times, has visited hundreds of pools, in order to present standards that

will help to solve the problems of swimming pool planning, construction, administration and law observance. His experience as participant, official, coach, teacher, administrator, member of the National Rules Committee, adviser on swimming pool planning and construction is evident in the scholarly treatment of the subject. He features the swimming pool primarily as a facility for health, physical education and recreation.

Of particular importance is the author's analysis of swimming pool laws, state and local board of health rules and regulations together with suggestions for their improvement.
