

Buildings Erected on K. U. Campus since

Chancellor Lindley came in 1920 --

- 1921 - Commons Building erected, formerly used as cafeteria; now houses the Department of Anatomy.
- 1921 - Power Plant erected
- 1921 - Six sections of Stadium erected
- 1921 - Elec. Engr. Laboratory erected
- 1923 - Central section of Frank Strong Hall erected
- 1923 - Corbin Hall (women's dormitory) built
- 1923 - First section of Watson Library built
- 1924 - Greenhouse erected
- 1925 - Two additional sections of Stadium erected
- 1926 - Memorial Union Building erected
- 1926 - Watkins Hall (dormitory for self-supporting girls) built
- 1927 - Stadium completed
- 1927 - Hoch Auditorium built
- 1929 - Snow Hall erected (replacing old Snow Hall)
- 1931 - Watkins Memorial Hospital built
- 1937 - Miller Hall (dormitory for self-supporting girls)
- 1937 - Watkins Home for Nurses of Student Hospital Staff
