Dear "Ole":

I am enclosing a copy of a publication which I have just received from Liston. It is the only copy I have and I would like to have it returned eventually. I would kindly ask, however, that you send this on to Major Griffith, and request him to return it to me.

You will notice many discrepancies in this bulletin. In the first place, there is the matter of the "James A. Hainith Trophy". This is really the "Maude Hainith Trophy". Dr. Hainith is still living. I also wish to call your attention to the district chairmen: Forrest Cox, from Colorado; Henry Iba, from Oklahoma Aggies; Dee Erickson, from Washburn College; Ed Hokey, from Creighton; Ray Hanson, from Western Illinois State Teachers College; Roy Clifford, from Western Reserve; A. F. Rupp, from the University of Kentucky; Clair Bee, of Long Island -- all of these fellows are members of the National Collegiate.

It seems to me that the officials of the N.C.A.A. should take this up with the proper parties and should fully inform them that these names are being used. Their names should be removed if they are listed here without the individuals' consent. You will recall at our last meeting of the N.C.A.A. this was to be done, and I thought you had done it, Ole. I think especially Cox, who is a member of the Rules Body, ought to know about this.
