
Dear Bill:

The attached circular, with a letter from Dr. Allen, should be of considerable importance to the N.C.A.A. .

This organization, the National Association of Intercollegiate Basketball, is in direct competition with the N.C.A.A. . The schools participating are largely those which are not eligible to join the N.C.A.A. because they are not willing to abide by our rules. It therefore seems incongruous to me that N.C.A.A. members should be represented on their committee. You will notice that a number of the N.C.A.A. schools are represented in this organization by their basketball coaches.

I am wondering if you do not want to bring this matter to the attention of the particular schools concerned. Liston is most antagonistic and critical of the whole set-up of the N.C.A.A. and therefore, to my mind, represents a group which should in no way receive the support of our organization.
