Dear Mr. Zachman:

I have just received a letter from Mr. H. V. Porter, secretary of the National Basketball Committee, in which he says:

"To date, no action has been taken relative to the time and place of next year's meeting. Chairman Floyd Rowe reports that a vote of the Executive Committee will be taken as soon as further information relative to related events is available. It has been definitely decided by the National Collegiate Athletic Association that the National Basketball Tournament will again be held at Kansas City on a date corresponding to that for the past tournament. This will probably have an influence on the choice of date and place of meeting for the Rules committee."

I am keeping you definitely in mind, and as soon as the date is set we will communicate with you at once. I am sure that you will pass this on to Jimmy Nixon, because we want you to know that we are pretty fond of the Municipal Auditorium family.
