Gentlemen:

Please find enclosed Financial Statement of the
"Big Six" Basketball Play-Off, held in Wichita, Kansas on
March 11 and 12, 1940. I am herewith enclosing a check for
your respective shares of the receipts after expenses have been
deducted. I am also enclosing an itemized statement of
Dr. F. C. Allen's Committee and Administrative Expense.

As a further explanation of the Officials' Expenses,
we wish to state that both Grable Duvall and Clarence Breithaupt's
expenses were \$50.00 each and their officiating fee \$20.00 per
game which totals \$180.00

The University of Kansas came to Wichita on the Rock
Island and returned by way of the Santa Fe, which made their
expense account higher than had they bought round trip on one
line. This was done on account of their class schedule and their
desire to return to the University as early as possible. Since
the University of Kansas team expense totaled \$251.96, we are
allowing the University of Oklahoma the same proportionate part
because there is a differential of thirty-eight cents in the
railroad fare between Lawrence and Wichita; and Norman and Wichita.
This would make a difference of \$4.56, thereby allowing Oklahoma
a total of \$247.40.

It was necessary to pay to Promoter Stauffer \$200.00
for rental of the Forum on account of the fact that he had a
wrestling attraction billed for Monday night, March 11. This
matter was explained to Coach Allen and he in turn explained it
to Coaches Drake and Edwards.
