

Cornhusker Hotel, 13th and M Streets

Rates: Single with bath, \$2.75-\$4.40; double with bath, \$3.85-\$6.50

Lincoln Hotel, 147 North Ninth Street

Rates: Single without bath, \$3.25; double without bath, \$3.25

Single with bath, \$3.50; double with bath, \$3.50-\$6.00

Three or more to a room, \$2 each.

(On account of the crowded conditions of hotels in these emergency times, it is suggested that delegates who would ordinarily ask for a single room indicate to the management if they are willing to share a room with one or more other delegates who are attending the Institute.)

Attendance At Meetings.

It is hoped that delegates will attend the entire session. Attendance of isolated meetings will have little meaning without the background of the other meetings.

Participation in Activities Of The Program.

Those who attend the Institute are not required to take active part in the program, but all who are willing to do so should bring gymnastic and swimming costumes with them. The women delegates may plan to use the University bathing suits but should furnish their own caps and bath shoes. Recommended costumes for men, tennis shoes, trousers, and shirt of washable material; and for women, tennis shoes and play suit, gymnasium suit, or slack suit. Towel and locker service will be furnished free of charge.

How to Find Your Way About In Lincoln.

In Lincoln the streets running east and west follow the letters of the alphabet, with "O" Street as the main street. The lettered streets A-M are south of O and those lettered P-Y are north. The streets running north and south are numbered, with 13th Street as the hub. First to 12th streets are west of 13th, and 14th on are east.

The University fronts on R Street between 10th and 14th, with the buildings to be used located as follows:

Student Union at 14th and R Streets.

Coliseum at 13th and Vine (V) Streets.

Grant Memorial Hall at 12th and S Streets. (Second building beyond R on 12th on west side of street)

The railroad stations are located as follows:

Burlington at 7th and P

Missouri Pacific at 9th and S

Rock Island at 21st and O

The main hotels are located as follows:

Capital Hotel at 11th and P

Cornhusker Hotel at 13th and M

Lincoln Hotel at 9th and P

Busses that Pass the University.

The bus marked "Ag College" goes down 13th Street to R, then to 14th and R, from there to 14th and Vine. These are the points nearest the 3 buildings where meetings will be held. The bus leaves 13th and M at 3 minutes before the hour and every 15 minutes thereafter. On the return trip to town it leaves 14th and Vine at 7 minutes after the hour and every 15 minutes thereafter.

The bus marked "University Place" goes from the Lincoln Hotel south to O Street, then east to 11th Street, then south to N Street, then east to 12th Street, then north to 12th and R; then east past the Student Union.
