College prospects tabbed in two-day tournament at Wyandotte high school included Neil Ridley, Columbus forward; Paul Churchill, Columbus guard; Bob Rolander. McPherson, center; Ivan Modrcin, Ward guard, and Bob Mackish, Wyandotte center. Evans, Peck, Schnellbacher, Nesmith and Pierce scouted meet.

Ridley is exceptionally fast, better than average passer, and has good basket eye. Can make a Big Six team. Churchill was good ball-handler, tough ball-hawker (Ridley excelled in this also) and better than average scorer. Ridley is smaller than Peck but well-built and durable. Churchill is larger.

Rolander is around 6-5 with pretty good action and good eye. He scored 21 points against Columbus. Two of his goals were tip-ins and two others recoveries under the hoop. He looked good all-around.

Modrcin is exceptionally fast and an excellent ball-handler. Also showed scoring possibilities and drove well from his spot at guard. Big enough to be rugged and will double in football as will Ridley.
