QUALIFICATIONS FOR PHYSICAL TRAINING PERSONNEL

- 1. ASSOCIATE DIRECTOR OF PHYSICAL TRAINING (CAF-9; Salary \$3,200 per year)
 - (a) Graduate of an accredited college or university with a B. S. degree or major in Physical Education, and

(b) Master degree from an accredited college or university with a major in Physical Education, and

(c) At least one additional year of graduate study in research, tests and measurements.

(d) A total of not less than four (4) years practical experience in physical training.

- 2. ASSISTANT DIRECTOR OF PHYSICAL TRAINING (CAF-7; Salary \$2,600 per year)
 - (a) Graduate of an accredited college or university with a B. S. degree or major in Physical Education.

(b) One (1) year of graduate study in field of Physical Education.

(c) Not less than three (3) years full time paid experience in the field of Physical Education.

(d) In lieu of graduate study, additional experience in the field of Physical Training may be substituted.

(e) Not over 30 years of age.

3. JUNIOR DIRECTOR OF PHYSICAL TRAINING (CAF-5; Salary \$2,000 per year)

(a) Graduate of an accredited college or university with a B. S. degree or major in Physical Education, or

(b) A graduate of an accredited college or university with a minor in Physical Education plus one year of graduate work in the field of Physical Education.

(c) In lieu of graduate study, two (2) years full time paid experience in Physical Education will be required.

(d) Not over 30 years of age.
