

### QUALIFICATIONS FOR PHYSICAL TRAINING PERSONNEL

1. ASSOCIATE DIRECTOR OF PHYSICAL TRAINING (CAF-9; Salary \$3,200 per year)
  - (a) Graduate of an accredited college or university with a B. S. degree or major in Physical Education, and
  - (b) Master degree from an accredited college or university with a major in Physical Education, and
  - (c) At least one additional year of graduate study in research, tests and measurements.
  - (d) A total of not less than four (4) years practical experience in physical training.
  
2. ASSISTANT DIRECTOR OF PHYSICAL TRAINING (CAF-7; Salary \$2,600 per year)
  - (a) Graduate of an accredited college or university with a B. S. degree or major in Physical Education.
  - (b) One (1) year of graduate study in field of Physical Education.
  - (c) Not less than three (3) years full time paid experience in the field of Physical Education.
  - (d) In lieu of graduate study, additional experience in the field of Physical Training may be substituted.
  - (e) Not over 30 years of age.
  
3. JUNIOR DIRECTOR OF PHYSICAL TRAINING (CAF-5; Salary \$2,000 per year)
  - (a) Graduate of an accredited college or university with a B. S. degree or major in Physical Education, or
  - (b) A graduate of an accredited college or university with a minor in Physical Education plus one year of graduate work in the field of Physical Education.
  - (c) In lieu of graduate study, two (2) years full time paid experience in Physical Education will be required.
  - (d) Not over 30 years of age.
