

Lawrence, Kansas, July 12, 1944--- The 1944 summer intramural program at the University of Kansas will get underway next week, according to Dr. F. C. Allen, head of the department of physical education. The program will continue to the end of the term in October. Because of the large number of requests for basketball the series will begin with that game.

Dr. Allen announced this morning that teams will form as desired by the men. Any group wishing to enter a team is welcome to do so, and any individuals desiring to play may join one of the teams to be organized for the competition. The games will be played in the evening in Robinson gymnasium on the short courts running north and south, and playing time will be somewhat shortened. A double or single Round Robin tournament will be carried out, depending on the number of teams entered.

Following the basketball championship games, the intramural program will change to softball and varsity basketball practice will begin. Dr. Allen will use the period for working with varsity candidates on fundamentals.

All through the summer, students will be welcome to take part in their favorite individual sports, including handball, tennis, horseshoes and golf. "Every man playing his own game," is Dr. Allen's long used slogan.
