Dr. Allen:

I have been checking with Mr. Wiebe on the loss of water from the swimming pool. A very conservative estimate is that we are losing 8,000 gallons of water from the pool every four days. Plumbers have checked the pipes and valves and can find no leakage there.

There must be some water seeping out through the bottom of the pool. Wiebe has been adding water every two days to keep the level where it should be. The chances are that if the water is seeping through the bottom, that the condition will get worse rather than better.

I do not think any repairs can be made which will help the situation — at least not immediately. We will continue adding water as we have been doing unless the situation becomes much worse in which case I'll let you know.

I felt you should know about this.
