We must have some plans ready for the committee. ur. Michols said he cetimated as high as a twenty-five per cent drop in emrollment, but soid that his guess was as good as nine. Of course, compulsory physical education would help our our situation scannikat. I would like for the men and the women to talk their problems over and come in to me before Hednosday.
