Dear Dr. Allen,

I am still unsuccessful in finding any one to take Mrs. Bauman's position for the second semester in the Physical Education Department.

Graduates who are qualified to fill the position are unwilling to come, first because there is no opportunity to continue study toward a Masters degree in Physical Education, and secondly because the salary is too low to meet their living expenses. If a Masters degree in Physical Education were offered at the University I believe the difficulty might be overcome.

I know the appointment is for only one semester, as two of the same family may not be on the University staff, but since Dr. Sherbon is still on leave on absence, would it not be possible to extend Mrs. Bauman's temporary appointment for the remainder of the year.
