Dear Miss Hoover and Mr. Allphin:

I have conferred with Mr. Crow, the University electrician, regarding a permanent electric connection at the west end of the pool, and I concur in his belief that it would be best to have the electricians make this connection each year as needed for the entertainments or demonstrations.

There is much danger in running a wire along to the west end and leaving it there permanently because of the possible contact where there is water. For that reason we believe it will be the safest to make the connections from time to time as needed.

Mr. Crow will put in a receptacle at the east end of the pool at once so that you may connect the electric phonograph there whenever you so desire.
