Dear Dr. Allen:

The Women's Physical Education Department would like very much to have the opportunity of placing practice or cadet teachers in the public schools. At the present time our majors have no practice teaching with the elementary school children; all of the work is done at Oread High School. We feel that the major student needs to have some practice teaching with the elementary school children because a number of them are going out into such positions.

Also, the fact that our senior majors are growing in number makes it difficult to give each individual senior as much real teaching experience as we feel she should have.

I would suggest the possibility of two hours practice teaching in the public schools and two hours in Oread.
