

MAP OF THE EUROPEAN WAR'S WESTERN FRONT



The northern flank of the Western front, where the forts, hidden pill boxes and block houses of the Maginot line in France and the Siegfried line in Germany face each other along the border. Between the lines of block houses and protecting all of the heavier fortifications, are lines of smaller concrete dugouts and pill boxes. It is between the main Maginot and Siegfried lines indicated by the block houses that the action on the Western front has centered, with the French driving into German territory but not yet penetrating the rear lines of heavier German fortifications. Keep this map to chart the course of the fighting.
