Received your letter thanking me for the sword. I'm happy you got it O.K. Thanks for the letter. I am busier than I ever was during combat. Since I'm Bn.-S.-I, Special Service Officer, Athletic officer & Trust Judge Advocate plus a few other duties they keep me running. I am coaching the Bn soft ball team and we are undefeated at present winning with 15 games under the belt.

We are doing our best to put on a big program with not near enough equipment. The shortage of soft balls & base balls is the toughest thing to overcome. We make our own bats. I have a fine basket ball court outdoors plus tennis courts and a grand track, with swimming pool attached.

We are in beautiful country and the weather is of fantastic variety. We don't know what is going to happen tomorrow but whatever it is we are ready.
