Dear Doc,

Just a note to let you know of my new location and to tell you we are doing well and are happy to be here putting an end to this mess. We are seeing lots of things and are getting quite an education. The going is pretty tough but the American soldier has more than it takes to do the job. The boys in this infantry receive everything they can get and need, and that goes for the Air Corps; and don't forget the Navy. They have been working swell. I didn't even get a note coming over, and that is something for me. I met a W. in the Air Corps the other day who is an old K.V. man. His name was Ramsey. I didn't know him when I was there. He is flying a P. 47 around now. I am writing this from a well dug in position so this may be a little messed up, but I hope you get it O.K. Haven't heard from you for quite awhile, so expect something any day. Tell everyone howdy for me.
