The Big Six Comforence has had quite a bit of difficulty in selecting their representative for the National Collegiate Athletic Association play-off in Remons City March 24 and 25. As amounted last week, Iom State by having the better offensive-defensive record them Oklahoma, was selected to represent the conference. Modride, sports editor of the Kanses City Star, George Edwards, basketball cosen of the University of Missouri, and a representative from the Missouri Valley Conference, to select a representative. The University of Missouri was asked because they had a civilian team. Assistant Bean San Shirkey, who is faculty representative of Missouri, was out of town and no decision could be had. Middle The representatives asked the Hig Six Selection Committee to ask Iowa State College to recommider, which they did, so the Iowa State Cyclones will be the Fifth District representative. Henry Iba's Oklahess Aggies, which would be the Missour's Valley Conference representative, would have been the team to meet in a play-off match with the Big Six representative, but since meet of the Missouri Valley teams had disbanded and since Oklahema Aggies had accepted the Invitation Tournment in New York, no play-off was necessary.

The Fifth District has always heretofore had a play-off series between the Big Six winner and the Missouri Valley winner. Therefore, this year when Iowa State has been selected by the Big Six as their representative they now become the Fifth District representative without a play-off. The Rocky Mountain District, which is the Seventh, has no representative, so the M.C.A.A. constitute has asked the University of Iowa to represent the Rocky Mountain area.
