Then, consistent with his modesty, he states, "Today I received a thrill when Admiral Mimits presented me with a Silver Star Medal for se-called gallant action. There were many others of our division receiving similar awards as a result of our Tarawa action. It was a real thrill to receive the smard from one of the big boys. Major Bill Jones, a former K.U. boy, also received the Silver Star Medal."

Bill Jones will be remembered as a Sig Alph back in 1937, and Fen was a Phi Pai, graduating in 1939. Fen further states, "I guess it has been all of three years or more since I last suw you and Mrs. Shank. Your boys will be grown, probably, when I see you again at this rate. Give my regards to all of my friends on the Hill.

Now, in closing, well do we remember General Douglas MacArthur's words which are carved in stone above the gymnasium of the United States Military Academy at West Point:

"On the fields of friendly strife are some The seeds which, in other years on other fields Will bear the fruits of victory."
