sell a bill of goods. In the district basketball tournament last March here in Lawrence, Kansas, the representatives of three large universities contacted two of the high school boys who happened to be football and basketball stars. So much money per month was offered these boys in a flagrant violation of these rules. Territories are invaded regardless of the location of the high school. Ninety dollars a month is the modest sum to be offered to these athletes. Remember, please, that this was in war time when athletes are offered \$90.00 a month, and when peace comes \$150 a month for twelve months in the year will be an ordinary amount that these top athletes can command.

The difficulty with the whole scheme of athletics is that there is nobody to enforce the rules as they are now constituted.
