Dear Harold:

Yes, we are planning on some games in Kansas City. I have written Rookhurst for the 12th of December, but have not heard from them.

We are also planning games for the 15th and 16th of December, and the 22nd and 23rd of December. Kansas may not play in the 15th and 16th games, and yet there is a possibility they might. But for the 22nd and 23rd we will have Missouri, Kansas State, Kansas, perhaps Colorado, and some other team as Colorado can only play one game.

For the 15th and 16th - neither date is closed entirely, but Oklahoma and the Iowa Seahawks will play one game, and we may have Wyoming and some other team to fill in the other games.
