Dear Mr. Stewart:

Your letter of April 23rd addressed to the Director of Athletics, University of Kansas, has been referred to me as Director of the Department of Physical Education.

I am enclosing a bulletin outlining the course of study for students desiring to major in Physical Education. I am also sending you an announcement of our compulsory physical conditioning program which was inaugurated this fall.

Four hours of credit in physical education may be counted toward a degree in most divisions of the University. However, under the plan for compulsory physical education a student would have eight semesters if he remained in school that long, but only four hours would be counted toward his graduation.
