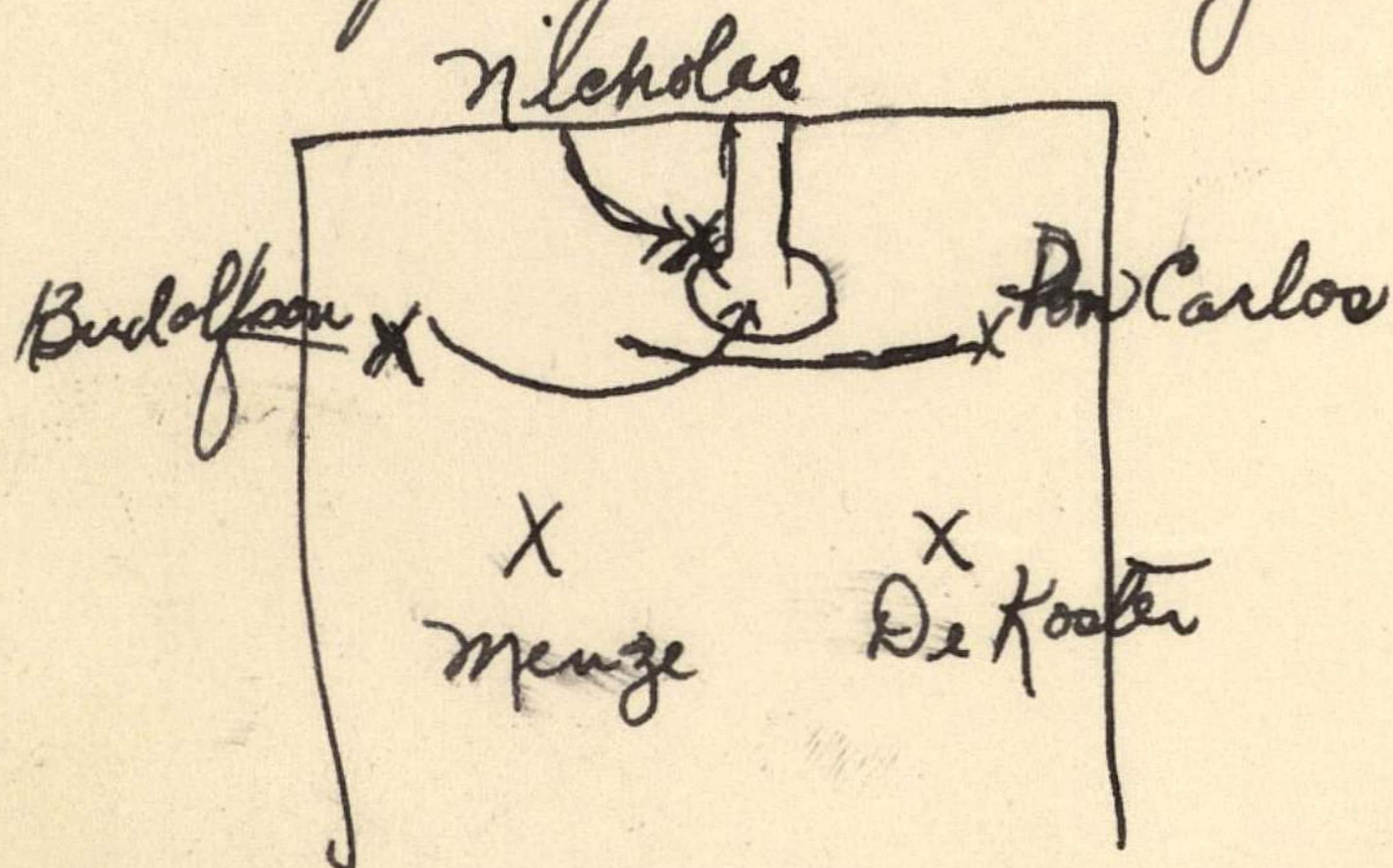


Iowa State uses the same kind of set plays as they ^{used} last year



Their best set play is simple, with Don Carlos screening for Budolfson and permitting the latter a shot at the free throw line. This play works on either side, but can be easily stopped by having the men guarding Budolfson and Don Carlos (or Harris) check off. This check must be made quickly, however, or the shot can still be made.

Meuze is a dangerous shot from around the free throw circle and must be more carefully and closely guarded than at Lawrence.

On their fast break, Budolfson is the first man down the court and will have to be checked momentarily
