We had him examined by a specialist last year who found that the arm has a tendency to pull out of the socket toward the front when holding a weight. Sometimes a quick motion may throw it out. It came out twice last year on the basket ball court.

The doctor recommended that he quit athletics until this fall. He seems O.K. now but I would like to get some form of support to protect him and also make him feel free while in the game. Can you recommend a support that would do him any good? He is my best Basket Ball player. He made an average of 14 points ^{per game} in the 6 games that he played last year.
