Upon receipt of his first letter I wrote to Captain Snyder telling him that at the time he was enrolled in the University there was a rule whereby all students in the College were automatically enrolled in Physical Education. If the student did not show up for class he was given a failing grade. R.O.T.C. work served as a substitute for physical education.

I told Captain Snyder that we were very desirous of doing everything we could to have this mistake corrected.
