Dear Phog:

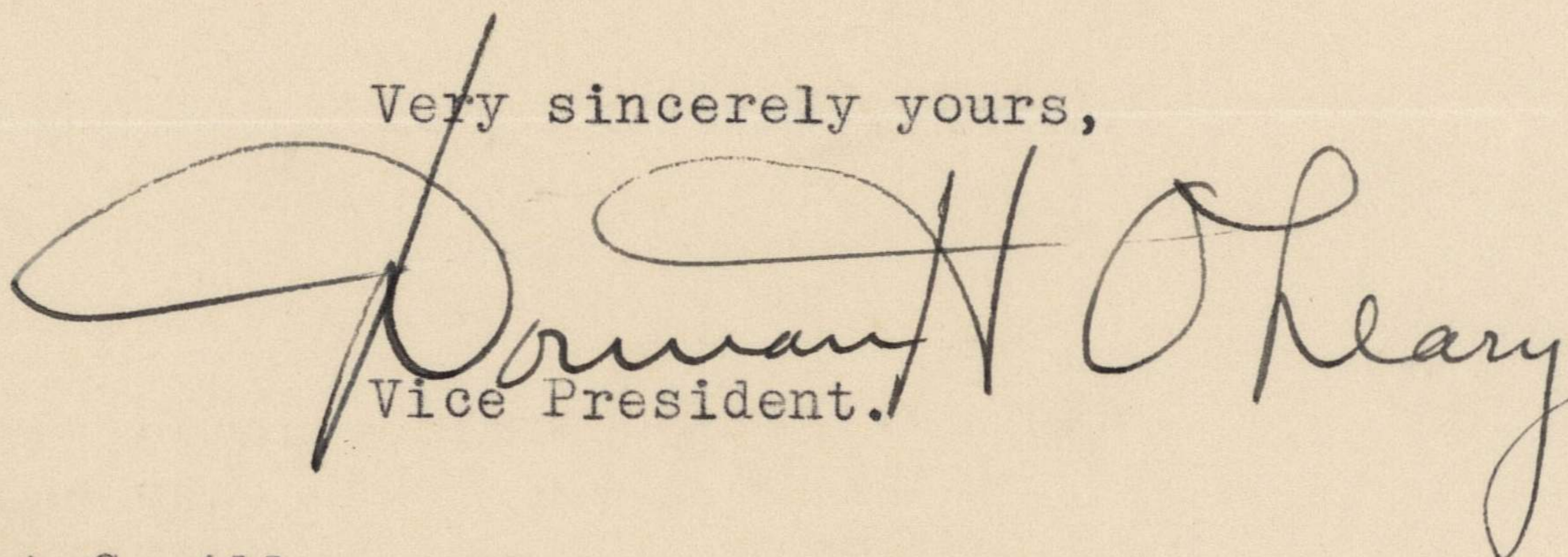
