Dear Fellow Directors:



Clifford Dean and Henry Shank jockeyed a little and challenged me to have Rotary match the Kiwanis gift.

Personally, I feel that we should do it this year, but for the future I am very much opposed to raising money in this manner. I am convinced that the money given to the Community Chest should include this splendid activity. We have promised our people that we would not solicit but once a year for all worthwhile things, save the Red Cross and the Tuberculosis Seal campaign.
