Dear Doctor Allen,

I am sending you the statistics of the Kansas State-Missouri game here Saturday night.

The 29 times the ball was brought from out of bounds across the black division line required 197 seconds, or an average of 6.8 seconds per trial. This is more than a second slower than the average time for the KS-KU game last Tuesday night.

There were 11 jump balls at one end circle, 17 at the other~~e~~ end, and 4 at the center ring. Total, 32.

No goals were made by either team after gaining a tipoff without possession of the ball going first to the other team.
