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


Muslin Magic




TWO SQUARES of muslin can work inexpensive magic for your Spring wardrobe. Here a muslin scarf is wound gracefully around the belt, imparting a distinctive note to the ensemble.



SIMPLY SEW two squares of muslin together at the back of the neck and arrange them in front to form a gilet and the entire effect of the frock is altered. The pin adds a chic note.



ANOTHER QUICK CHANGE is possible by using the muslin as a belt, tied at the front. To heighten the effect, have the two pieces of muslin of contrasting colors. This is muslin magic, indeed.

HOLLAND LOOKS ALOFT. One of the world's most peaceful nations, Holland takes precautionary measures with Europe seething as dictator's armies are on the march.




THE EYES OF ENGLAND are turned toward the air. With "anything likely to happen," London tests its defenses and keeps unceasing watch on the skies above London.




MEDITERRANEAN MANEUVERS are not confined to Italy's fleet. French warships also sail Mare Nostrum in these days of stress.




