I know that you will not be found at this address since your promotion but I am writing to thank you for your kindness in mentioning to me Tony Grambrone and Don Rendina. I am writing each of these boys today, and enclosing a carbon copy of my letter to them to you.

We will be glad to give both of them jobs at 35¢ an hour. You know about what a boy can make. He could make from \$18 to \$20 a month if he wants to work. It is better for you to tell them the set-up here than for me to write a long detailed letter because generally the boys shop around with these letters and try to get someone else to raise the ante.
