- (5) It was decided that we would have a table with a sign marked "Officials" which was to designate the official scoring and timing table.
- (6) Will you kindly submit to me your ideas on how we should go about making out our schedules in the future. I will compile these suggestions and send them on to you.

## RULES INTERPRETATION AND CONDUCT OF THE GAME:
