they permit Tucker to play in the Big Six before the end of the first semester this year.

I will deresay that if Tucker were a football player and desired to compete under these rules there would be enough protest to keep him from participating. But many of the athletic directors in the Big Six are not concerned about stirring up any administrative disturbance unless it affects their own personal situation. It is too bad that the administration is so lax. Outside of Mike Ahearn and possibly George Veenker, there is very little to hope for in the way of durable administrative outlook.
