I am enclosing herewith copies of correspondence just received from Lieutenant Commander R. A. Brown concerning arrangements for a game with the Great Lakes basketball team in the Municipal Auditorium in Kansas City on February 5th.

I am planning to have a conference with Mr. Zachman, the manager of the Auditorium, and work out a program with him so that the proper advertising and publicity can be had with a minimum of expense. Our agreement with the Great Lakes people is to split fifty-fifty after the expenses of the hall are taken out.

Mr. Zachman is very enthusiastic about this and we believe that we should make some very good money, and it will also bring the University of Kansas in very favorable light, we hope.
