I apologize for having overlooked your title in my previous correspondence with the Auditorium authorities concerning our basketball dates.

J. B. "Red" Anderson, the coach at Rockhurst College, and I have agreed upon December 11 for our game there with Rockhurst. I am sure we will draw a good crowd at that game. I will appreciate it if you will send contracts for December 11. I believe it might be better if they were made out to Mr. Gwinn Henry, Director of Athletics at the University of Kansas.

I am returning a signed copy of the contract for our game with the Great Lakes Naval Training Station to be played in the Auditorium on January 30. You may release the January 29th date, because the arrangements the Great Lakes people made with George Edwards abrogated the plan that Hank Iba and I had of playing double headers in the Auditorium on January 29 and 30. However, we do plan to play Bernie Bierman's Naval Aviation team but no date has been agreed upon for that game. That will have to be worked out later.
