I've just been talking to the transportation men of the New York Central and Pennsylvania Railroads here; Neither of these gentlemen anticipate any difficulty in handling the movement of basketball teams into and out of New York City, but both wished me to impress on the visiting teams that it would be wise to make reservations and plans from three to four weeks earlier than would customarily be done for such trips.
