
Dear "Phog":

Received your letter of June 9 regarding Missouri-Kansas-Great Lakes setup in basketball.

I was sorry to hear that you had scheduled the Iowa Naval Cadets for a game in Kansas City the night before we play you. Such a previous game, undoubtedly, will detract from our game the following night. I believe, under the circumstances, we should try to arrange some form of double-header on the 29th and 30th. Naturally we did not know of Missouri's drawing power in Kansas City, but we do believe on January 29, a Missouri-Great Lakes game, and a Kansas-Iowa Naval game, followed on January 30 with a Kansas-Great Lakes game, and a Missouri-Iowa Naval game, ought to have more drawing power than the present arrangement.
