Dear Virgil:

Fearing that George Edwards had perhaps mislaid the letter that I wrote him as of December 2nd, giving full explanation regarding the financial arrangement, I am sending you a copy of that letter.

We have no contract other than a letter to Tony Hinkle and to Jack Gardner, appraising them of the financial arrangement. Jack Gardner will get a guarantee of \$150.00 a game and after all of the expenses of advertising, hall rental, officials' fees, and so forth, all of which are paid by the Auditorium, including the guarantee to Gardner, then Missouri, Kansas and Great Lakes will share the profit three ways.

We will send a copy of the financial statement of the Municipal Auditorium to the management of the three teams.
