Thank you for your kind letter of the 13th instant.

Why not use Parke Carroll with Ted O'Sullivan to work our game on December 8th? Parke and Ted team together pretty well, and I would prefer the team-work pair.

In regard to the convex backboard, the convexity is 4 inches on each side from the center to the outer edge. The board is 6 by 4 feet, and the convexity is 4 inches in 3 feet.

We are using these boards and we like them, although we think the convexity is a little bit accentuated in the first 18 inches from the median plane of the board. If this convexity could be pushed out a little more from the center it would still give a more fertile banking field, in my opinion.
