and enjoy the said Office of our Lieutenant
General in our said Charittee Islands,
during our Pleasure, with all Rights,
Privileges and Advantages to the same
belonging or appertaining, and We do
hereby authorize and require you, without
expecting any other Order or Warrant
from Us, or any other Person whatever,
in case of the Death or absence of our
Captain General in and over our said
Islands, now and for the time being,
to execute and perform all and singular
the Powers and Authorities contained
in our Commission granted to our said
Captain General, according to such
Instructions as our said Captain General
hath or shall have received, or you shall
at any time receive from Us in that
Behalf, and We do hereby command
all and singular our Officers, Ministers
and loving Subjects of our said Lewis
Charittee Islands, and all others whom
it

it may concern to take due Notice hereof,
and to give their ready Obedience hereunto
accordingly. Given at our Court at
Carlton House the eighteenth day of December
1713 in the Fifty fourth year of our Reign.
